Aloha Residents, Families, Friends, and Employees,

As of today, we have confirmed 10 residents that tested positive for COVID-19, as well as 3 positive direct care employees. When a positive result is found, employees, residents, and responsible parties of the positive resident will be notified. We encourage all responsible parties to notify residents' family and friends.

May 11, 2023, CMS marked the end of the federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declaration. CMS guidelines for reporting COVID positive cases, as well as facility outbreaks, have changed. Although, as an organization, Aloha Nursing Rehab Centre is no longer required to communicate COVID information in the manner that we have been in the past, we would still like to continue open communication with our residents, their families, and friends, as well as our employees.

We will continue to post updates to our website as they become available. There will also be signage posted on our entrance doorway, and a message posted in our Accushield kiosk for you to receive any important information regarding COVID while you are checking in prior to entering the facility for your visit. If an important update has been released on our website, we plan to send an automated call to residents' and/or responsible parties to alert them to check the site.
