Aloha Residents, Families and Friends,

With a heavy heart we must inform you that we received confirmation today that a member of our non-direct care staff tested positive for COVID-19. The last day this employee worked was on 12/18/2020. The employee who tested positive is currently on isolation at home. We have notified officials at the Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) as required and are following procedures recommended by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC), along with abiding by DOH guidelines. Aloha Nursing Rehab Centre is following its infection control plan carefully to contain and prevent potential spread. In an abundance of caution, we are in the process of coordinating facility wide testing of residents and employees. Per CMS guidelines, **all visitation to Aloha Nursing Rehab Centre has been cancelled until further notice.** We will continue to encourage and offer web based video meetings and phone calls.

Precautions include:

- Employee and essential vendors/ contractors are screened for any COVID-19 symptoms, including fever prior to entering the building.
- Employee and essential vendors/ contractors are asked a set of screening questions to ensure there will be minimal risk of exposure to others.
- All employees are required to wear appropriate PPE at all times as recommended by CDC.
- High touch surfaces are disinfected frequently.
- Physical distancing required throughout facility.
- We continue to follow infection control protocol including frequent hand hygiene.
